The Western States Air Resources (WESTAR) Council is pleased to accept the Western Regional Air Partnership's request to move the WRAP organization to WESTAR. Members of WESTAR have benefited greatly from the opportunity to collaborate with our federal, tribal, and local partners on issues of common concern. We are eager to continue this rewarding relationship and this move will ensure that the Partnership will continue for years to come.

As WESTAR's Executive Director, I have been directed by my membership to work with the WRAP Board of Directors to complete the move of WRAP to WESTAR by no later than WESTAR's fall business meeting, tentatively scheduled for November 2013.
